

Can a big battery provide inertia services in Australia?

And now we have a prime example at a large scale. Tesla's "Big Battery" in South Australia got approval from the Australian Energy Market Operator to provide inertia services for the National Electricity Market in Australia.

Will solar power help South Australia's inertia shortfall?

Do solar and wind power provide inertia services?

Solar and wind power don't provide these inertia services for the grid, so grid operators need to find something else to rely on instead of coal and natural gas power plants in order to avoid turning on old coal power plants to provide that service as more renewables get built.

What is the principle of inertia?

Inertia is similar to the principle of Newton's First Law: objects will remain in their state of motion unless a force i.e. friction makes them stop. In other words, if something's moving, it keeps moving. In electricity, the "motion" comes in the form of the rotating motors or turbines that spin to generate energy in power plants.

What is inertia and how does it affect the grid?

Inertia is the stored kinetic energy of these rotating turbines in the system. Because the turbines spin at the same frequency as the grid, they effectively act as a "shock absorber" against any rapid change. Grid frequency changes constantly - if demand grows then frequency falls and vice-versa.
