

What is an electric storage heater?

Also known as night storage heaters, electric storage heaters warm up your house whilst making the most of off-peak electricity prices. They store thermal energy by heating up internal ceramic or clay bricks at night when electricity tends to be off-peak and cheaper. This heat is then released during the day to keep your house warm.

How do electric thermal storage heaters work?

**Electric Thermal Storage Heaters Mechanism** Electric Thermal Storage Heaters use low-priced electricity (off-peak periods) to store heat in their ceramic bricks; stored heat is then used later, typically during daytime. If the difference in the On/Off electricity rates is considerable, that can provide lower energy bills.

Are electric storage heaters energy efficient?

Many electric utilities have energy efficiency credits programs that makes electric storage heaters heat even more economical by offering you credits based on the number and size of heaters you install in your home. Electric storage heating is the best price-sensitive heating solution on the market.

Can Electric Storage heaters be eliminated?

If the difference in the On/Off electricity rates is considerable, that can provide lower energy bills. Part of the stored heat - sometimes estimated at 40%-60% - is lost during the storage period. New and more efficient electric storage heaters can reduce these percentages, but they can't be eliminated.

How do you charge a storage heater?

Use the input dial to charge the storage heater. The input dial controls how much energy is stored in the heater overnight. It usually has settings ranging from 1 to 5. The higher you set your storage heater to, the more energy it will store. As a general rule, choose a low setting during warmer months and a high setting during colder months.

Do you need an electrician to install a storage heater?

Electric storage heaters must be installed by a qualified electrician. Unlike plug-in storage heaters, they're installed directly into your home. Contact local electricians in your area and ask whether they perform storage heater installation. Talk to several different electricians before making a decision to compare installation prices.
