IP54 Enclosure
 IP54 is a standard for ingress protection (IP) for electrical enclosures. It is defined by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) in the IEC 60529 standard. IP54 enclosures are designed to protect electrical equipment from dust and water. The '5' in IP54 indicates that the enclosure is dust-protected, meaning that it is designed to prevent dust from entering the enclosure. The '4' in IP54 indicates that the enclosure is water-protected, meaning that it is designed to prevent water from entering the enclosure. IP54 enclosures are commonly used in industrial and outdoor applications where electrical equipment is exposed to dust and water. Examples of IP54 enclosures include outdoor lighting fixtures, industrial control cabinets, and outdoor telecommunications equipment.

What Does The IP Code Mean?

What Testing Do IP54 Enclosures undergo?
