

How did DEFA support the Isle of Man's bee keepers?

The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture ('DEFA') supported the Isle of Man's Bee Keepers through the introduction of the 'Bee Diseases and Pest Control (Isle of Man) Order 2008'. This Order enabled the department, through its Bee Inspector, to complete a programme of testing for Varroa destructor (causes Varroasis of bees).

Is the Isle of Man free of Varroa?

The EU Council Decision 2015/266 of 16 February 2015 accepted the Isle of Man as free of Varroa and permits us to prohibit the importation of bees in any stage of their life cycle, used hives, skeps or any receptacle used to house bees.

What is the Isle of Man known for?

The Isle of Man is also known for the TT Motorcycle Races, and the Manx cat, a breed with short or no tails. In 2016, UNESCO awarded the Isle of Man biosphere reserve status.

Why has the Isle of Man suspended the import of bees?

The Isle of Man has suspended the import of bees, apiculture products and used beekeeping equipment into the Isle of Man from Reunion. This is due to an ongoing outbreak of small hive beetle. Who is the head of state of the Isle of Man?
