

Does Israel have a potential for solar energy production?

Israel's location and climate allow a high potential for solar energy production. This report investigates solar and renewable energy development in Israel's past, and present, as well as future plans. How much solar power will Israel have by 2050?

In the most solar-focused scenario, the country would have a PV capacity of 108 GW. The Israeli Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure has published a roadmap for net-zero emissions in the energy sector by 2050, heavily relying on solar energy.

Are photovoltaic solar panels available in Israel?

There are various size fields with photovoltaic solar panels in Israel. These solar energy producers have an agreement with the Israeli government, ensuring the electric company will purchase the energy at a price that fluctuates according to the market's cost production. Between 2004 - 2017 Israel's energy usage more than tripled itself.
