

Will Italy support a centralized electricity storage system?

The European Commission has approved, under the European Union's state aid rules, a EUR 17.7 billion scheme with which Italy intends to support the establishment and operation of a centralized electricity storage system.

How will Italy's electricity storage subsidies work?

After winning clearance in Brussels, Italy can now select companies developing electricity storage projects eligible for subsidies. The mechanism is set to cover investment and operating costs through annual payments.

Does Italy have a battery storage market?

Italy has both a rapidly growing utility-scale market as well as a flourishing customer-sited battery storage market. Customer-sited storage adoption has been mainly driven by a combination of high electricity prices and generous tax incentives.

How many GW of electricity can a storage facility produce?

The plan is to support electricity storage facilities with 9 GW in total operating power and an overall capacity of 71 GWh until the end of 2033. The production of electricity from renewable energy sources depends on sunlight, wind and hydrology, and the electricity demand curve is different.
