Are battery energy storage systems needed in Italy?

Therefore, battery energy storage systems (BESS) are needed in Italy. The Italian market for BESS is growing rapidly and currently amounts to 2.3 GW but it almost exclusively consists of residential scale systems, associated with small scale solar plants, having a capacity of less than 20 kWh.

Does Italy need electricity storage?

As Italy's energy mix is increasingly composed of variable renewable energy sources, electricity storage will be needed to integrate power generated by renewables into the national grid and make it available when sun and wind energy are not accessible.

Does Italy need a small storage system?

Italy simplified permitting for small storage systems last year but the country still needs to readjust its medium-term plans to make them coherent with its ambitious climate and energy targets. "Storage needs to be considered, also in line with the European approach, as a market player, similar to a generating asset," said Canazza.

Why is battery storage so important for solar power Europe?

Walburga Hemetsberger, CEO of SolarPower Europe, said, "Growing battery storage and flexibility represents a fundamental shift from our current grid-centric view of the market. It impacts not only the way we plan infrastructure and the way we operate the system, but also the markets we engage with.

Will Italy be able to connect a photovoltaic plant to the electricity network?

The majority of existing battery systems in Italy are connected to a photovoltaic plant, so this will be one of the first stand-alone battery projects connecting directly to the electricity network. Italy has commendable plans to bring renewables' share of final gross electricity production to 73% by 2030 and 95-100% by 2050.
