

What percentage of Italy's electricity comes from solar?

According to Eurostat, approximately 11.6% of Italy's electricity now comes from solar energy, while 8.8% is generated from wind power, making Italy one of Europe's leaders in renewable energy. However, these impressive numbers represent just the beginning.

What is concentrated solar power in Italy?

Italy currently maintains various concentrated solar power (CSP) projects. Concentrated solar power plants concentrate solar energy into single points of collection with, for instance, mirrors, to maximise energy capture. Four types of CSP technologies are currently available on the market.

Does Italy have a solar power plant?
