What is a community microgrid?

A community microgrid is technically a group of interconnected loads and distributed energy resources (DER) within clearly defined electrical boundaries which acts as a single controllable entity with respect to the grid. A community microgrid can connect or disconnect from the grid to enable it to operate in both grid-connected or island-mode.

What is a microgrid & how does it work?

As defined by the US Department of Energy (DOE): 'A microgrid is a group of interconnected loads and distributed energy resources within clearly defined electrical boundaries that acts as a single controllable entity with respect to the grid.

Is Kosovo a member of the Energy Community?

Kosovo is a member of the Energy Community, an international organisation that brings together the European Union and its neighbours in southeast Europe to create an integrated pan-European energy market. The organisation was founded by the 2006 Energy Community Treaty to extend the EU internal energy market to southeast Europe.

What is a microgrid (MG)?

One of the most frequently used definitions of a MG is presented by the USA Department of Energy (DOE): 'A microgrid is a group of interconnected loads and distributed energy resources within clearly defined electrical boundaries that acts as a single controllable entity with respect to the grid.

Can an energy community exist without a microgrid?

An energy community or a community energy initiative may exist without a microgrid. Technically, a community microgrid can function without the associated community engagement, although it can be argued that it would miss a significant opportunity by doing so.

Who owns a community microgrid?

Ownership and governance structures The ownership and management of community microgrids can vary greatly, from being owned and operated by utility companies, local members, third-party investors, or a combination of them. Governance structures can similarly vary, encompassing energy cooperatives, corporations and no-profit associations .

How will more widespread adoption of community microgrids be implemented? Community microgrids are going to really take off if we can identify the factors that tend to yield cost effective microgrids in community settings - ...
