

Does Laos have a solar power plant?

In addition to hydropower, Laos has also been exploring other renewable energy sources, such as solar and biomass. The country's first large-scale solar power plant, with a capacity of 10 MW, was commissioned in 2018, and several other solar projects are currently under development.

What is the main energy source in Laos?

As of 2018, most of primary energy comes from coal (60.7%), followed by hydropower 30% and oil 18%. Hydropower is a significant resource in Laos, with 22.5 TWh electricity generated in 2018. However, the national electrification rate was 94.2% in 2017.

How much power does Laos have?

With the Mekong River running through its territory, Laos has the ability to generate up to 28,000 megawatts (MW) of electricity from hydropower, making it the "Battery of Southeast Asia." Currently, the country has around 6,000 MW of installed hydropower capacity, with plans to increase this to 14,000 MW by 2030.

Is Laos a power hub?

As part of the Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS) and the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Power Grid, Laos has been actively participating in cross-border power trade and interconnection projects. The country's strategic location, combined with its abundant hydropower resources, makes it an ideal hub for regional power trade.

Does Lao PDR export electricity to Thailand?

Oil, the major supply for the transport sector, grew at a slower rate of 8.5% per year and biomass, the major supply for the residential sector, grew at an average rate of 1.7% per year. The Lao PDR exports most of its electricity to Thailand.

Why is Laos a good hub for regional power trade?

The country's strategic location, combined with its abundant hydropower resources, makes it an ideal hub for regional power trade. In fact, Laos currently exports around 70% of its electricity to neighboring countries, and this figure is expected to rise in the coming years as more hydropower projects come online.

The Lao PDR's total final energy consumption (TFEC) grew by 2.7% from 2010 to 2018 (Figure 10.1). Electricity grew the fastest at 10.5% per year, followed by petroleum products at 7.3%. Biomass consumption, which has the highest share in the TFEC, decreased at an average rate

In terms of primary energy demand, 80% of the demand is met by renewable energy sources and 20% by non renewable energy sources. The renewable energy sources include biomass (68% of the total demand), hydro

(12% of the total demand). The non-renewable energy sources include oil (17% of total demand) and coal (3% of the total demand).
