

Is Liechtenstein an energy country?

"Energy country": all of Liechtenstein's municipalities have been awarded the "Energy City" label. Liechtenstein is the world's first "energy country". Voters in Liechtenstein have approved the Principality's accession to the International Monetary Fund (IMF) with a vote share of 55.8 percent.

Is Liechtenstein a solar power station?

Samina Power Station, currently the largest of the domestic power stations, has been operational since December 1949. In 2011-2015, it underwent a reconstruction that converted it into a pumped-storage hydroelectric power station. In recent decades, renewable energy efforts in Liechtenstein have also branched out into solar energy production.

What is Liechtenstein's national power company?

Liechtenstein's national power company is Liechtensteinische Kraftwerke (LKW, Liechtenstein Power Stations), which operates the country's existing power stations, maintains the electric grid and provides related services. In 2010, the country's domestic electricity production amounted to 80,105 MWh.

How do Liechtenstein municipalities get the energy City label?

Liechtenstein municipalities can obtain the Energy City label if they continuously ensure efficient energy use, increase investments for renewables, including solar energy, wind energy and hydropower, and promote environmentally compatible mobility. The certificate is awarded by the Energy City Sponsoring Association.
