In recent years, liquid air energy storage (LAES) has gained prominence as an alternative to existing large-scale electrical energy storage solutions such as compressed air (CAES) and pumped hydro energy storage (PHES), especially in the context of medium-to-long-term storage.

Cold energy utilization research has focused on improving the efficiencyof liquid air production and storage. Studies have shown that leveraging LNG cold energy can reduce specific energy consumption for liquid air production by up to 7.45 %.

Liquid air energy storage (LAES) has the potential to overcome the drawbacks of the previous technologies and can integrate well with existing equipment and power systems.

Why do we use liquid air as a storage medium?
