

How will Luxembourg improve its energy system?

In this context, Luxembourg plans to expand and upgrade its electricity grids, but the country would benefit further from the deployment of measures to increase energy storage and demand-side response in its power system. Is Luxembourg a net energy importer?

Luxembourg is a net energy importer; 81.5% of the electricity consumed in the country, for example, was imported from neighboring European countries in 2021. There was no decline in the climate change gas emissions (CO<sub>2</sub>) from year 2008 to 2012 in Luxembourg. There was no better efficiency in the use of electricity from 2008 to 2012.

Does Luxembourg have a good energy network?

Luxembourg has a well-developed energy network that serves all homes in the country. Creos operates and maintains Luxembourg's electricity network and gas pipelines. However, you'll receive your energy supply through only a handful of providers.

How much energy does Luxembourg use?

According to IEA, the electricity use (gross production + imports - exports - transmission/distribution losses) in Luxembourg in 2008 was 7.7 TWh and population 0.49 million people. Luxembourg was dependent on imported energy in 2008. Own production was 2% of primary energy in 2008.

Who regulates energy suppliers in Luxembourg?

Energy suppliers in Luxembourg are regulated by the national regulator, ILR (Institut Luxembourgeois de Régulation). If you have a complaint about your energy provider or your initial complaint has not been resolved, you should contact the ILR and use their mediation service.

When did Luxembourg start constructing a nuclear power plant?

The 1970s energy crisis led Luxembourg to briefly consider constructing a nuclear power plant. In 1972 RWE and the government negotiated a project to build a 1,200 MW nuclear reactor along the Moselle river near Remerschen. In 1974 there were already signs that there was little support for the project among public opinion.
