

Are Bonaire and Sint-Eustatius honoured?

Late last week, the good news was received that the project proposals of Bonaire, Sint-Eustatius and Saba were honoured. They are the only islands in the Caribbean whose proposals made it through the selection.

Who is the representative of Bonaire Sint Eustatius & Saba?

The Representative for the public bodies of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius and Saba represents the Government of the Netherlands on the islands and also performs tasks similar to a King's Commissioner. [citation needed] The current representative is Gilbert Isabella.

What are Bonaire & Sint Eustatius?

These are the islands of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, and Saba, [10][nb 1] as they are also known in legislation, or the BES islands (an acronym of their names; most people believe, however, it's an acronym for 'Bijzondere Eilandelijke Status' meaning special island status) for short.

How much does energy cost in Bonaire?

At the same time, the islands of Curaçao and Sint Maarten became constituent countries (Dutch: landen) within the Kingdom of the Netherlands. The island of Aruba is also an constituent country of the Kingdom; Aruba gaining its status in 1986 after seceding from The Netherlands Antilles.

In Bonaire, Sint Eustatius and Saba there are 93.52 people per square kilometers (0.386102 square miles), if

spaced out evenly. 10.71 infants die at birth out of a 1000 new born in Bonaire, Sint Eustatius and Saba.

Despite being grouped together as the Caribbean Netherlands, the island of Bonaire is in fact just over 800 kilometers away from the other islands of Eustatius and Saba. Bonaire is just off the coast of Venezuela, while Saba and Eustatius are just to the east of Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands. Yet all of them feature true natural beauty.
