

What is the basis of stability in a microgrid?

The basis of stability in the microgrid was based on controllable resources. In these sources, the more accurate, robust, and practical the control process used, the more it improves the stability of the microgrid. For this purpose, different control levels are used sequentially in a microgrid.

Why do microgrids become more complex than PI-controllers?

The presence of nonlinear factors in the model of some microgrid components causes the microgrid structure to become more complex and the PID-controller to control frequency fluctuations does not perform as well as the PI-controller.

How does a microgrid work?

When connected to the grid, the microgrid's frequency and power are functions of the main grid and only need to be controlled for the power of the units, but on islands, the microgrid's frequency and voltage fluctuate and need an independent control [3, 4].

Why are the Falkland Islands considering a wind-diesel hybrid system?

It includes a small flywheel in order to further increase the efficiency of the wind-diesel hybrid system. Although the utility conducted both hydro and solar power experiments, the wind resource on the island greatly exceeds the potential resource for either of these two technologies. The Falkland Islands are therefore considering this option.
