

What kind of battery does a Toyota Mirai use?

Lithium-ion battery The new Mirai is equipped with lithium-ion high-voltage battery in place of the current model's nickel-metal hydride unit. Although smaller in size, it is more energy-dense, giving higher output and superior environmental performance.

What is the Mirai's battery and how does it work?

The Mirai is equipped with a 1.24 kWh lithium-ion battery that stores excess electricity generated by the fuel cell stack or recovered via regeneration. This battery is located above the motor on the rear axle and provides immediate power when needed.

How does the Toyota Mirai cool the battery?

Cooling air for the battery is silently pulled in from the cabin. In the Toyota Mirai, compressed hydrogen fuel is stored in three 10,000-psi carbon-fiber-reinforced high-pressure tanks: one mounted longitudinally in the center of the car; another mounted transversely under the rear seat, and a third below the battery.

How does the Mirai's fuel cell produce power?

The Mirai's fuel cell generates 128 kW of power and can cold-start at temperatures down to -22°F (-30°C). The power output comes from a fuel cell stack that is about 20 percent smaller and 50 percent lighter than the previous generation. This buffer battery sits above the motor on the rear axle and provides immediate power when needed.

Is the Toyota Mirai a hydrogen fuel cell electric vehicle?

As a hydrogen fuel cell electric vehicle, the Toyota Mirai has a driving experience that's unique. From a powertrain standpoint, a 114 kilowatt (153 horsepower) electric motor has been tasked with turning the wheels, and with 247 lb-ft of torque, it is spritely off the line.

How does the new Mirai power supply work?

The new Mirai is equipped with the following two different power supply functions as a standard feature: During a disaster or other emergencies, a large amount of electricity can be supplied to home or electric devices by connecting to the external power supply (sold separately).
