

What is M-kopa Solar?

What is included in the M-Kopa IV solar home system?

The M-Kopa IV Solar Home System includes a solar panel, control unit, three low-energy LED light bulbs (one of which is a portable, rechargeable torch) and a rechargeable radio. The control unit also has a USB port for charging cellphones.

How does M-Kopa work?

The M-KOPA systems are bought for a small price,and customers purchase daily credit using M-Pesa's mobile money payment system. After a year each customer owns their system outright and they no longer have to pay for power.

Where is M-Kopa based?

M-Kopa expanded from its east African base to Nigeriain 2021 and has more recently started operations in Ghana. It is testing the market in South Africa and also running pilot projects to finance electric motorbikes as part of a new e-mobility strategy.
