

What is a mobile energy storage system (mess)?

During emergencies via a shift in the produced energy, mobile energy storage systems (MESSs) can store excess energy on an island, and then use it in another location without sufficient energy supply and at another time, which provides high flexibility for distribution system operators to make disaster recovery decisions.

Can mobile energy storage systems improve resilience of distribution systems?

Does a mobile energy storage system meet transportation time requirements?
