

What is mobile energy storage?

Based on this, mobile energy storage is one of the most prominent solutions recently considered by the scientific and engineering communities to address the challenges of distribution systems .

What is a mobile energy storage system (mess)?

During emergencies via a shift in the produced energy, mobile energy storage systems (MESSs) can store excess energy on an island, and then use it in another location without sufficient energy supply and at another time, which provides high flexibility for distribution system operators to make disaster recovery decisions .
