Simultaneously, Moldova has taken significant steps to promote renewable energy sources in recent years. Installed capacity has reached 132.7 MW for wind power, 115.3 MW for net metering, 76.9 MW for solar power, 16.8 MW for hydropower, and 6.6 MW for biogas. As a result, Moldova achieved a total of 348.3 MW in 2023.
