Liquid air energy storage (LAES) gives operators an economical, long-term storage solution for excess and off-peak energy. LAES plants can provide large-scale, long-term energy storage with hundreds of megawatts of output. Ideally, plants can use industrial waste heat or cold from applications to further improve the efficiency of the system.

As seen in the scope, this corresponds to about 15 MWh of energy storage. This figure shows the performance of the hot and cold thermal stores. The two cold stores capture about 5.1 MWh and 2.3 MWh of energy from the expansion of liquid air and releases about 3.8 MWh and 1.7 MWh of it to the charge cycle.

ANALYSIS BY STORAGE CAPACITY. Indeed, the government has named liquid air energy storage, compressed air energy storage, and flow batteries as technologies that would "benefit from investor support." According to DESNZ analysis, if 20GW of LDES is deployed, the electricity system could save £24 billion (US\$31 billion) between 2025 and 2050.
