

What is Morocco's New Energy Strategy?

Hydropower program In Morocco's new energy strategy, 14% of the country's energy production will come from hydropower by 2020. Installed hydropower capacity will be increased from 1,730 MW in 2008 to 2,000 MW in 2020 through the construction of new hydropower dams and Pumped Energy Transfer Station (PETS).

Does Morocco need energy storage?

For instance, Morocco itself has a target of having 52% of its installed capacity coming from renewable sources, but this is not a target it can reach without energy storage to provide the essential flexibility needed for renewable energy production at scale.

How does electricity storage work in Morocco?

It ensures the storage of electricity produced by renewable energies in order to adapt fluctuating supply to shifting demand. The first large-scale electricity storage project in Morocco is the 460 MW Afourer Pumped Storage Power Station (PETS), commissioned in 2004.

It consists of a hydraulic system composed of two 1.3 million-m³ water reservoirs connected by a pipeline with two hydroelectric production units between the basins.

How much energy does Morocco produce from renewables?

Production of energy from renewables lagged behind a little, at closer to 20% of the country's total in 2019. But the country has come a long way. Morocco has since pledged to increase the renewables in its electricity mix to 52% by 2030, made up of 20% solar, 20% wind and 12% hydro.

How much electricity does Morocco use?

Morocco's electricity consumption in TWh. In 2018, Morocco installed 34% of renewable energy (i.e. 3,700 MW), divided as follows: 1,770 MW, 1,220 MW and 711 MW respectively originate from hydroelectricity, wind power and solar energy.
