

Which energy storage technology is most attractive?

NREL examined 15 energy storage technologies at various stages of commercialization. Ignoring cost, most of these technologies could support the grid with either short or long durations. However, rapid declines in lithium-ion battery costs make it the most attractive energy storage technology.

What is the future of energy storage?

Storage enables electricity systems to remain in balance despite variations in wind and solar availability, allowing for cost-effective deep decarbonization while maintaining reliability. The Future of Energy Storage report is an essential analysis of this key component in decarbonizing our energy infrastructure and combating climate change.

What are the different types of energy storage technologies?

Other similar technologies include the use of excess energy to compress and store air, then release it to turn generator turbines. Alternatively, there are electrochemical technologies, such as vanadium flow batteries.

Could energy storage be the future of the grid?

Together, the model enhancements opened the door to exploring many new research questions about energy storage on the future grid. Across all modeled scenarios, NREL found diurnal storage deployment could range from 130 gigawatts to 680 gigawatts in 2050, which is enough to support renewable generation of 80% or higher.

Which technologies are most suitable for long-term storage applications?

Capacity costs (Figure ES.1). Generally, technologies with low energy-capacity costs and high power-capacity costs (the blue area in the figure) are most suitable for longer duration storage applications (up to multiple days) and less frequent charge-discharge cycles; these include thermal, chemical, metal-air battery, and
