

Are phase change materials a viable alternative to energy storage?

Phase change materials (PCMs) can alleviate concerns over energy to some extent by reversibly storing a tremendous amount of renewable and sustainable thermal energy. However, the low thermal conductivity, low electrical conductivity, and weak photoabsorption of pure PCMs hinder their wider applicability and development.

Are phase change materials a good thermal storage medium?

Phase change materials (PCMs) are a promising thermal storage medium because they can absorb and release their latent heat as they transition phases, usually between solid and liquid. Because phase change occurs at a nearly constant temperature, useful energy can be provided or stored for a longer period at a steady temperature.

Are PCM thermal storage techniques more energy efficient?

Challenges and opportunities exist for researchers to develop PCM thermal storage techniques that are both more energy dense and more efficient.

Can cascaded thermal energy storage solve a PCM problem?

During the discharge process, cascaded thermal energy storage works efficiently and has the potential to solve the problem of PCM at the end of the storage not likely to be used for latent heat storage since the temperature of heat transfer fluid rises (Mehling and Cabeza, 2008).

How can energy storage improve the penetration of intermittent resources?

Energy storage can increase the penetration of intermittent resources by improving power system flexibility, reducing energy curtailment and minimising system costs. By the end of 2018 the global capacity for pump hydropower storage reached 160 GW whereas the global capacity for battery storage totalled around 3 GW (REN21 2019).
