In addition to crude oil, Myanmar indigenous production also includes coal, gas, hydro, biomass, and other renewables (solar and wind). Compared with energy imports, Myanmar's total indigenous energy production grew more slowly at an average rate of 5.1% per year.

How can Myanmar address the concerns arising from infrastructure developments?

Addressing the concerns arising from Myanmar's infrastructure developments will require significant effort in strengthening institutions, implementing a strong regulatory framework and ensuring transparency.

After the completion of energy infrastructure projects in the KPSEZ, BRI-led economic development projects for Kyaukphyu have ceased or been shuttered. With the increase in fighting between Myanmar's military junta and rebel groups in the region, it's likely that Chinese companies will cancel projects or delay them until the fighting is resolved.
