

How will solar power benefit Namibia?

The generation of solar power will complement Namibia's available green energy portfolio, such as hydro-electricity, which already constitutes more than two-thirds of our installed power capacity. Electrifying key parts of our economy and of our neighbours will spur unprecedented economic activity and growth for Namibia and Southern Africa.

Does Namibia have a solar power plant?

The government, the ECB, and NamPower have all expressed interest in grid-connected solar and wind renewable solutions, and in May 2015, Namibia inaugurated its first-ever solar power plant - a 4.5 MW plant - which represents one percent of the country's current production of energy.

Are there energy resources in Namibia?

Geological data suggests that there are considerable oil and gas reserves in the Walvis, Luderitz and Orange River offshore basins. Namibia has considerable solar, biomass, hydropower and wind energy resources; while the total installed renewable energy capacity was 431 MW in 2018, the total opportunity is many times greater.

Where does Namibia's electricity come from?

The imported electricity is provided by the Southern African Power Pool (SAPP) primarily from South Africa. Looking at the energy sector more broadly, the total primary energy supply (TPES) in Namibia in 2017 was 20,350 GWh. 15,350 GWh of this TPES came from crude oil, which was all imported into the country.

Is Namibia a good country for solar energy?

With an average of ten hours of sunshine per day, Namibia is one of the world's sunniest countries. It has enormous potential for solar energy, yet, 60% of the country's energy is imported from neighbouring countries and 40% of its population is disconnected from the grid. Nonetheless, Namibia has ambitious goals.

What are Namibia's energy goals?

Nonetheless, Namibia has ambitious goals. By 2030, it wants to produce 70% of its energy from renewable energy sources, with independent energy producers feeding renewable energy into its national grid. In northern Namibia, a ten-hectare solar energy farm produces 9,000 MWh of energy per year.
