

How does energy development contribute to the growth of regional power demand?

The subsequent development and reallocation of energy-intensive industries has contributed to the growth of regional power demand. Furthermore, policies accelerating the electrification of energy end-use have also contributed to the growth of the overall electricity demand.

When did Denmark start requiring heat and power plants to settle?
