Is Nd₂Fe₁₇ a ferromagnetic material?

Nd₂Fe₁₇ is another Nd-based interesting magnetic material. Nd₂Fe₁₇ is known to crystallize in rhombohedral Th₂Zn₁₇ structure type with the space group R $\bar{3}m$. This compound has gained back interest since it was shown that insertion of interstitial atoms could raise the usually low Curie temperature (T_c) of this ferromagnetic compound.
