

What is a battery energy storage system?

A battery energy storage system (BESS) is an electrochemical device that charges (or collects energy) from the grid or a power plant and then discharges that energy at a later time to provide electricity or other grid services when needed.

Are energy storage systems safe?

The emergence of energy storage systems (ESSs), due to production from alternative energies such as wind and solar installations, has driven the need for installation requirements within the National Electrical Code (NEC) for the safe installation of these energy storage systems.

What is battery storage & why is it important?

Battery storage is one of several technology options that can enhance power system flexibility and enable high levels of renewable energy integration.

Does a pre-engineered or self-contained energy storage system need ventilation?

Provisions need to be made for sufficient diffusion and ventilation of any possible gases from the storage device to prevent the accumulation of an explosive mixture. A pre-engineered or self-contained energy storage system is permitted to provide ventilation in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations and listing for the system.

Why is ventilation important in a battery storage system?

Appropriate ventilation is important to dissipate harmful off-gassing that can result from the use of batteries. Provisions need to be made for sufficient diffusion and ventilation of any possible gases from the storage device to prevent the accumulation of an explosive mixture.

As defined by 2020 NEC 706.2, an ESS is "one or more components assembled together capable of storing energy and providing electrical energy into the premises wiring system or an electric power ...

Section 706.5 in the 2017 NEC simply requires the various elements of an energy storage system to be listed (other than lead-acid batteries), and it requires complete systems to be listed as an assembly.
