

How many energy storage projects are there in Australia?

This is the first time Australian storage projects have broken the billion-dollar barrier in a single quarter. These 6 energy storage projects will add 3,802 MWh to Australia's storage capacity. What is Australia's energy storage capacity?

Australia had 2,325 MW of capacity in 2022 and this is expected to rise to 22,076 MW by 2030. Listed below are the five largest energy storage projects by capacity in Australia, according to GlobalData's power database.
