

Does Norfolk Island have too much solar energy?

That's pretty impressive given its remoteness and a population of 1,849. But this uptake has also caused some headaches in managing Norfolk Island's electricity network, with too much solar energy goodness generated at times. The Tesla battery system installed in December 2020 has helped out on that front.

How many solar panels are there in Norfolk Island?

When will a new meter be installed in Norfolk?

Replacement of the island's legacy electricity meters with time of use meters began in September 2023. It is anticipated that the rollout of all new meters will take approximately six months. Council's contracted installers notify Norfolk Telecom customers by SMS weekly on the planned meter installation route for the upcoming week.

Will Norfolk be 100% renewable by 2024?

Norfolk Regional Council has set its sights on 100% renewables by 2024, introducing feed-in tariffs and reducing the highest consumption tariff of \$0.72 per kilowatt-hour by at least half by that year.
