

What is a compressed air energy storage system?

Today's systems, which are based on the conservation and utilization of pressurized air, are usually recognized as compressed air energy storage (CAES) systems. The practical use of compressed air dates back to around 2000 B.C. when bellows were used to deliver a blast of air for the metal smelting process.

What is an ocean-compressed air energy storage system?

Seymour [98, 99] introduced the concept of an OCAES system as a modified CAES system as an alternative to underground cavern. An ocean-compressed air energy storage system concept design was developed by Saniei et al. and was further analysed and optimized by Park et al.

What is the thermodynamic analysis of a compressed air energy storage system?

The study presented by Wu et al. describes the thermodynamic analysis of a novel compressed air energy storage system powered by renewables. The thermal storage in this system is realized in the form of thermochemical storage, utilizing the process of the reduction of Co_3O_4 to CoO .

How does a compressed air energy storage plant work?

A Compressed Air Energy Storage (CAES) plant works by pumping and storing air in an underground cavity or a container when excess or low-cost electricity is available. The stored energy is recovered by mixing the compressed air with natural gas. This compressed mixture is burned and expanded in a modified thermal turbine.
