

Which utility-scale energy storage options are available in Oman?

Reviewing the status of three utility-scale energy storage options: pumped hydroelectric energy storage (PHES), compressed air energy storage, and hydrogen storage. Conducting a techno-economic case study on utilising PHES facilities to supply peak demand in Oman.

Is Oman ready to move away from the shared ownership structure?

Gas fields and processing plants are operated by PDO exclusively on behalf of the government and EDO. Looking to the future, Oman is prepared to move away from the shared ownership structure that is typified by PDO, allowing both domestic and international players to operate more independently.

How much polyethylene & polypropylene will Oman produce a year?

The facility promises to produce an additional 838,000 tonnes of polyethylene and about 215,000 tonnes of polypropylene per year, raising total production of both products in Oman to 1.4m tonnes per year from around 1m tonnes, according to OQ.

How can energy storage improve the penetration of intermittent resources?

Energy storage can increase the penetration of intermittent resources by improving power system flexibility, reducing energy curtailment and minimising system costs. By the end of 2018 the global capacity for pump hydropower storage reached 160 GW whereas the global capacity for battery storage totalled around 3 GW (REN21 2019 ).
