

Can metals be used as energy storage media?

In addition, the stored metal could be integrated in district heating and cooling, using, e.g., water-ammonia heat pumps. Finally, other abundant reactive metals such as magnesium, zinc, and even sodium could be exploited as energy storage media and carriers as alternative to hydrogen and other liquid or gaseous fuels.

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Is reversibly storing energy in materials defects possible?

Yet, defect concentrations as high as ~10 at.% have been recently achieved in thin crystals of MoS₂, with potential for stored energies much greater than those reported here. While feasible in principle, reversibly storing energy in materials defects poses significant practical challenges.
