

How does the EU support the green transition of the Palestinian economy?

We work together with our Palestinian partners to support their efforts in the green transition of the Palestinian economy. What is 'green growth Palestine'?

"Green Growth Palestine", in cooperation with the European Development Partners notably from Belgium, Sweden, and Italy, will work with the Palestinian Ministry of National Economy to increase the efficiency of energy, raw material, and water use in production, cut emissions and waste and promote circular business models.

Is the EU a donor to Palestine?

Today the Commission published the results of its review of the ongoing EU financial assistance for Palestine, announced two days after the Hamas's terrorist attack on Israel on 7 October. President of the European Commission, Ursula von der Leyen, highlighted, that "The EU is the largest international donor of aid to the Palestinians.

Who does the EU support in the Occupied Palestinian territories?

The EU supports numerous humanitarian partners in the occupied Palestinian territories: United Nations agencies, the Red Cross and Red Crescent, and international non-governmental organisations. Since 2000, the EU has provided more than EUR1.1 billion in humanitarian assistance to help meet the basic needs of the Palestinian population.

Does the European Commission support the Palestinian Authority?

The European Commission is currently developing a more substantial multi-annual support programme for the Palestinian Authority to strengthen its capacity in view of a two-state solution and safety and security in the region.

How does the EU help Palestinians?

The EU has been providing humanitarian assistance to Palestinians in need since 2000, supporting people affected by emergencies and shocks.
