

How many hydro power plants are there in Papua New Guinea?

Papua New Guinea generates hydro-powered energy from 6 hydro power plants across the country. In total, these hydro power plants have a capacity of 165.0 MW. What is hydropower? Hydropower, also known as hydroelectric power, is a form of renewable energy that generates electricity by harnessing the power of moving water.

Where is the new Papua New Guinea hydropower plant located?

Located in Papua New Guinea's Morobe province, the new hydropower plant involved the design and construction of several bespoke components including: A low-height diversion weir connected to a 33m high concrete surge tank A power station containing two 5.6 MW Pelton turbines.
