Overall, this study reveals that the functional porous carbon obtained from peanut shell waste can be used as a promising and eye-catching high-performance SCs material, and also encourages the efficient application of biomass waste in the field of energy storage.

What if peanut shells were produced from conventional energy sources?

It has also been taken into account that if the energy that can be produced from peanut shells were produced from conventional energy sources, these would generate 0.357 t of CO 2. Therefore, the global CO 2 savings would be equivalent to if the energy produced by the peanut shell were produced by conventional sources.

Can peanut shell be used to remove organic dyes from waste water?
