

It comprises the islands of Pitcairn, Henderson, Ducie and Oeno. Pitcairn, the only inhabited island, is a small volcanic outcrop situated in the South Pacific at latitude 25.04 south and longitude 130.06 west. It is roughly 2170 km (1350 miles) east south-east of Tahiti and just over 6600 km (4100 miles) from Panama.

The journey began in 2011, with a formal marine reserve proposal in 2013, support from the UK government, and the establishment of the Pitcairn Island Marine Reserve in 2015. Now, Pitcairn's marine science base ensures ongoing preservation efforts, protecting precious marine life for future generations.

Beginning in 2011, the Pew Environment Group's Global Ocean Legacy project worked with the Pitcairn islanders to create this marine sanctuary. In 2012, a National Geographic expedition assessed the health of the marine environment around the islands, discovering thriving ecosystems and new species.

The Pitcairn Islands Marine Protected Area (MPA) Management Plan sets out ways to ensure effective management of the MPA over the next five years. Pitcairn Islands, encompassing four islands in a 43.25 km² area, achieved a significant milestone in March 2019.

With a population of only around fifty, the people of Pitcairn are descended from the mutineers of HMAV Bounty and their Tahitian companions. Pitcairn Island is approximately 3.2km (2 miles) long and 1.6km (1 mile) wide with the capital Adamstown located above Bounty Bay and accessed by the aptly named road, "The Hill of Difficulty".
