How much subsidy does India provide for rooftop solar panels?

The government provides generous subsidies to incentivize the adoption of rooftop solar panels: Solar systems up to 2 kW: Subsidy of Rs. 30,000 per kW. Additional capacity up to 3 kW: Subsidy of Rs. 18,000 per kW. Total subsidy for systems exceeding 3 kW: Maximum of Rs. 78,000.

The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has issued operational guidelines to set up one model solar village in every district of the country under the PM-Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana. An amount of INR8 billion (~\$95.2 million) has been allocated for this component, with a provision of INR10 million (~\$119,110) in central financial assistance for each model village.
