Who funds the Port Moresby power grid development project?

2.0 BACKGROUND OVERVIEW The Port Moresby Power Grid Development Project is funded by ADB loan 2998/2999-PNG¹. The Project Agreement was signed between ADB, the Independent Public Business Corporation (IPBC)², and PPL on the 28th of May 2013.

What type of power does Port Moresby use?

Port Moresby primarily uses thermal fuels for power generation. However, there are exceptions such as a 58 MW hydropower system at the Ok Tedi Mining Limited (OTML) mines and a geothermal plant that supplies power to the Lihir Gold mine.

What works are involved in the Port Moresby project?

Works as part of the project include the rehabilitation, reinforcement and upgrade of infrastructure on the Port Moresby, Ramu and Gazelle grids owned and operated by PNG Power Limited (PPL).

Will diesel generation be reduced in Port Moresby?

The use of diesel generation in Port Moresby is expected to be substantially reduced. The demand in Port Moresby is growing rapidly, and the country's power system has inadequate reserve capacity, making it unable to meet the demand, especially during dry seasons when water flow is low.

Why does Papua New Guinea need affordable electricity?

"Access to reliable, affordable electricity is central to economic development; businesses, schools, hospitals and clinics, among countless other services in PNG, all need reliable, affordable power to keep the country growing," said Stefano Mocci, World Bank Country Manager for Papua New Guinea.

Does ADB support the electricity sector in PNG?

ADB's support to the electricity sector in PNG cannot be fully assessed yet, as two loan projects and one grant project are still in the early stages of implementation. (60. Achievement of physical outcomes)
