What is the Emirates national grid project?

The Emirates National Grid project aims to interconnect the following four authorities that are responsible for supplying power throughout the emirates: Sharjah Electricity, Water and Gas Authority (SEWGA).

How many GW of electricity does the UAE have?

At present,there are over 27 gigawatts(GW) of installed capacity to generate electricity across the seven emirates utilising natural gas,which is the cleanest fossil fuel available. The UAE is looking at increasing its target for generating power from clean energy to 27 per cent by 2021.

Is the UAE integrating the emirates into a more efficient national grid?

State-led entities manage the domestic electricity grid in each of the seven emirates,but the UAE is making progresstoward integrating the emirates into a more efficient national grid. The Emirates National Grid project aims to interconnect the following four authorities that are responsible for supplying power throughout the emirates:

Where is Hamriyah power plant located?

It is located just 600m south of Hamriyah port,close to and west of Hamriyah Free Zone on the coastline of the Arabian Gulf. The Hamriyah combined-cycle power plant features three 600MW-equivalent power units,each of which is equipped with a gas turbine,heat recovery steam generators and a steam turbine.

What is the capacity of Sharjah power plant?

It has a nominal capacity of 1.8GW. The Sharjah Electricity and Water Authority (SEWA) developed the project under a build-own-operate-transfer (BOOT) scheme,together with co-developers GE Capital,Sumitomo,Shikoku Electric Power and Sharjah Asset Management. The investment decision on the project was taken in May 2019.
