What is reduced-order model of energy storage?

Reduced-order Model of ESS: KESS and TESS are the gain and time constant of the energy storage, PESS and QESS are the output active and reactive power of the energy storage. By varying the time constant, the type of energy storage and power converter are reproduced.

How to model energy storage?

One of the approaches in modeling ESSs is to reproduce them with an ideal voltage source  $V_{dc}$  and a detailed VSC (Fig. 10). Fig. 10. Ideal DC link model of the ESS. In this model, the energy storage is reproduced by a DC voltage in accordance with the output characteristics of the particular energy storage unit.
