

Puerto Rico applications of energy storage

What is Puerto Rico's battery energy storage system?

The Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority's battery energy storage system is a 20,000kW energy storage project located in Puerto Rico. It was announced in 2018 and will be commissioned in 2020. The Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority owns the system (100%).

Who can apply for a solar & battery storage project in Puerto Rico?

Applicants for this funding opportunity may include individual entities or teams based in Puerto Rico that can coordinate the deployment of solar and battery storage systems across many individual sites. DOE will award up to \$325 million for solar and battery storage systems across two types of community infrastructure:

Does Puerto Rico have a community-level energy resilience program?

This program aims to improve community-level energy resilience for vulnerable populations across Puerto Rico, funding solar and battery storage installations for community healthcare facilities as well as community centers and other common areas within public housing and privately owned subsidized multi-family properties.

What is Puerto Rico's energy strategy?

The assessment was made according to International Atomic Energy Agency criteria. Key to the analysis is Puerto Rico's energy strategy, which is to rebuild from the damage of 2017's Hurricane Maria in a more resilient way by creating a web of microgrids.

How much money does Puerto Rico have to pay for solar?

Up to \$190 million is available to Puerto Rico's Housing Administration and a private company to pay for solar and battery installations in public housing common areas and subsidized, multifamily housing properties. Another \$175 million is available for certain healthcare and dialysis centers.
