

Where are Redflow batteries made?

The batteries are manufactured in facilities located in Mexico and Thailand. In February 2023, Redflow signed an agreement to supply a 4MWh of battery project using zinc-bromine flow battery to Energy Queensland, which is marked as their largest Australian project of zinc-bromine flow batteries.

Does Redflow have a X10 battery?

Will Redflow build a new battery factory in Queensland?

Redflow aims to launch a large MWh-scale version of its battery based on its existing stack design, known as X10, and has been working to secure financing to support the plan. After "significant commercial interest" in the solution, it proposed to build a new factory to make those batteries in Queensland.

What is Redflow battery technology?

Founded in 2008, Redflow designs flow battery technology that offers a much longer duration, safer and longer lasting alternative to lithium ion. Its batteries use water-based electrolytes, which act as a fire retardant, making them ideal for critical infrastructure like hospitals, power stations and military bases.

Where are Redflow zbm3 batteries made?

These batteries are manufactured in Redflow's Thailand facility and come with a standard 1 year warranty that can be extended to 10 years with an additional cost. How much do Redflow ZBM3 batteries cost? Redflow's ZBM3 batteries cost around \$11,000 to \$12,000 excluding installation.
