

Does Romania have a strong energy sector?

The Romanian state operates with great caution in the energy sector, aiming to prevent price increases for its citizens and thus slowing down the development process. Nonetheless, Romania has ambitious plans for its energy sector.

How much investment does Romania need to achieve the energy strategy?

Investment needs to achieve the objectives of the Romanian Energy Strategy are estimated as EUR 127 billion overall from 2021 to 2030 (annually around 6% of current GDP), mostly in energy demand sectors. The use of Union level funding sources such as cohesion policy or the Modernisation Fund is not yet specified.

Why does Romania support a long-term perspective of natural gas?

Romania supports a long-term perspective of natural gas in the European Green Pact because it forecasts that this resource will remain an important tool in changing the energy sector and transitioning to a more sustainable and carbon-free economy.

What is Romania's energy transformation?

Renewable energy sources, nuclear power (via completion of Cernavoda NPP Units 3 and 4, refurbishment of Unit 1, and deployment of SMRs), and natural gas - the latter considered a transitional energy source - form the backbone of Romania's energy transformation. Romania's coal production is expected to decrease by 12.5% in 2023 .

Is Romania a future European Energy Hub?

As European countries struggle to cut ties with their unstable Eastern partner, Romania is increasingly seen as a future European energy hub. Romania is the second largest producer of natural gas in the European Union, after the Netherlands.

Why is Romania still dependent on imported gas?

Despite Romania's rich energy potential, the country is still dependent on imported gas - to a greater or lesser extent, depending on the season. This setback can be attributed to the delay in exploitation of gas resources from the Black Sea and from land, as well as the fact that Romania's energy sector is largely handled by state companies.
