#### Will KEPCO build a solar farm in Guam?

In a separate deal, Kepco secured a contract to build a 132-megawatt solar farm equipped with an energy storage system in Guam by 2027, and sell electricity to the local power authority for a 25-year period. The project was clinched as part of a consortium that includes other Korean firms, such as Samsung S&T.

#### Does core tech solar have a legal dispute with Guam Waterworks Authority?

Commissioners did raise some concerns about the award to Core Tech Solar, as affiliate company Core Tech International is currently locked in a multi-million-dollar legal battlewith the Guam Waterworks Authority. GPA needs approval from the CCU, before taking the contract awards to the rate-setting Public Utilities Commission for final approval.

### How much does Riyadh solar project cost?

The project, expected to cost 1.5 trillion won, is aimed at constructing a 2-gigawatt solar power plant about 523 kilometers (325 miles) north of Riyadh to supply electricity in the region for 25 years, according to the Korean company.

### How much does a solar farm cost in Mangilao?

Immediately after the Ukudu groundbreaking,GPA and KEPCO officials proceeded to Sasayan Valley in Mangilao for a ribbon-cutting that marked the official launch of the island's largest solar farm. The 60-MW Mangilao solar farm began operating last month,generating energy under the contract purchase price of \$0.085/kWh.

#### Why is Core Tech suing Guam?

The matter is ongoing before the Superior Court of Guam. GovGuam along with GWA are suing Core Tech,in the hopes of revoking certificates of title that show the company owns the plant land. Core Tech has countersued, seeking \$220 million in back rent and damages for the property.

Masdar, the UAE clean energy company, has won a contract with Chinese and South Korean partners to develop a 2GW solar project in Saudi Arabia. The company, along with its partners GD Power of China and the Korea Electric Power Corporation, will build the plant at Al Sadawi, about 500km north of Riyadh in the Eastern Province.

KEPCO was also named the preferred bidder for Guam's fourth solar project in 2023 worth 600 billion won. KEPCO plans to advance its renewable energy and integrated projects, including energy storage systems (ESS) by focusing on the Middle East. If KEPCO wins the Saudi deals, it will be KEPCO's first solar power project in the region.
