

How to send a 'timeout' signal to a process if time limit is reached?

By default, the 'timeout' command sends a TERM signal to the process when the time limit is reached. However, you can specify a different signal using the -s option. Here's an example: # If the script.sh runs for more than 30 minutes, a HUP signal will be sent to it.

What happens if a timeout is 0?

A duration of 0 disables the associated timeout. Upon timeout, send the TERM signal to COMMAND, if no other SIGNAL specified. The TERM signal kills any process that does not block or catch that signal. It may be necessary to use the KILL signal, since this signal can't be caught.

What does command stderr do when timeout is not running?

Specifies the signal to be sent on timeout. Specifies the kill signal to be sent after a grace period. Exit with the same status as COMMAND, even when the command times out. When not running timeout directly from a shell prompt, allow COMMAND to read from the TTY and get TTY signals. Diagnose to stderr any signal sent upon timeout.
