

What are agsol solar-powered mills?

The mills have zero fuel cost, and are designed to serve from the household to community level. The product is designed, manufactured, and distributed by Agsol.

We wanted to test this, so we recently acquired a 2.2kW electric 3-phase hammer mill, from Agsol in Kenya, to test at our existing rural off-grid productive use mini-hub in Ormoti.
