Will Korea become a battery technology hub?

How much will LG Energy Solution invest in a battery plant?

LG Energy Solution, a South Korean battery maker, announced on Monday plans to invest \$3.1 billion (4 trillion won) from this year to 2026 in a facility producing batteries for electric vehicles and other goods.

Does Korea import EV batteries?

According to the government, Korea is heavily dependent on the import of EV battery components. Korea imports 47.2 percent of cathodes and 80 percent of anodes. Nearly 70 percent of separators used in Korean batteries and 66.2 percent of electrolytes are imported.

Where will LG Energy Solution build the Institute of battery Tech?

LG Energy Solution will build the Institute of Battery Tech at its No. 2 Ochang factory in North Chungcheong to educate and build expertise in battery technologies. The institute will be housed in a six-story building with a Jan. 2023 completion date. New equipment will be added to the No. 2 factory for the manufacturing of prototypes.

Will Korea expand its EV battery capacity?

The government estimates that once Korea further expands its battery capacity through the massive investment and establishment of the battery ecosystem, it expects earnings from electric vehicle (EV) batteries to expand seven fold from 22.7 trillion won in 2020 to 166 trillion won by 2030.
