

What is a 5 MW power plant in Seychelles?

The 5-MW plant will be the first project led by an Independent Power Producer(IPP) in Seychelles. The project,which is anticipated to commence in July,will be built on a lagoon on Mahé, the main island of the archipelagic nation.

How many solar panels will be installed in Seychelles?

The project is the first solar array to be spearheaded by an IPP in Seychelles,claimed Qair. The solar plant will require 13,500 solar panels,which will be built across 40,000 square metres of water. Upon completion,the installation will account for about 2 per cent of total power generation in the island nation.

Will Seychelles get a floating PV project?

It bid for the floating PV project as part of a consortium involving Seychelles-based PV installer VetiverTech. According to IRENA,the country currently has an installed 0.9 MW of solar capacity by the end of 2018.

What is the world's largest floating solar power plant?

In Seychelles,French developer Qair,has been selected to develop the largest floating solar power plant to be installed on saltwater in the world. The 5-MWplant will be the first project led by an Independent Power Producer (IPP) in Seychelles.
